A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF LIBERTY TOWNSHIP, ADAMS COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, DETERMINING A FORM OF NOTICE TO PROPERTY OWNERS FOR REMOVING TREES WITHIN THE RIGHT-OF-WAY HAVING A TRUNK DIAMETER IN EXCESS OF SIX INCHES

WHEREAS, Article XXIII, Section 2325 (a) of The Pennsylvania Second Class Township Code states that the Board of Supervisors or its agents shall not remove any shrub or tree growing within the right-of-way of any township road or street except those shrubs and trees the board of supervisors finds to constitute a hazardous or dangerous condition to the use of the highway or those which impair the use or maintenance of the public road or street. No tree having a trunk diameter in excess of six inches shall be removed without notice of the proposed removal having first been given to the abutting property owner. The township supervisors shall determine by resolution the form of notice to property owners.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Supervisors of Liberty Township, Adams County, Pennsylvania, determines the form of notice to property owners to be a letter sent by first class mail ten days prior to the tree cutting.
